MAINTENANCE ITEMS COMPLETED:

- Inner Docks 2 dock carts were repaired; 2x6 boards were re-attached on both sides of slips 37 & 49; numbers on floating dock by slips 52 & 55 were re-attached; new hammers were installed on the new fire extinguishers boxes; box support at slip 41 was secured; palm limbs were cut and disposed of; 3 new landscape timbers were installed; 2x6 on walkway was repaired; 5 ramps were cleaned, prepped, and touch- up paint was applied; carpet was removed and disposed of, 2x4 rub rail and deck boards were re-attached at slip 22 & 23; all finger piers were checked for needed repairs; limbs in water at the north ramp were removed; board on walkway entrance was replaced; deck board at slip 2 was flipped; erosion problem on south side of board walkway was inspected, decking was removed, and two 4ft. sections of 2x10s were installed for erosion problem; trash & recycle containers were cleaned and sanitized; the 6th pole light (from east end on north side) was replaced.
- Outer Docks Breaker in small box was checked & reset; pole light breaker on pier was reset; lock on small gray breaker box H was installed; 10 deck boards and loose boards in center section of floating dock at slip77 were secured; light fixture at pedestal slip 71 was replaced.
- General Labor Day decorations were installed and removed.

EXTREMELY HIGH TIDE on SEPT. 26, 27, & 28 2015:

- <u>Pictured below is of the west end of the inner docks.</u> The floating docks and the boardwalk around the marina were the same height; all ramps were going up hill. The dept of the water under the boat in slip 38 (near the west end of the marina) was 11ft.
- On the outer docks the ramp going from the pier walkway to the floating docks was flat out straight (level with the pier walkway). THAT'S A HIGH TIDE!!!!!!!
- <u>Thank you to everyone!</u> All boats bilge pumps and drain systems worked well. There were no boats in distress during that high tide period.
